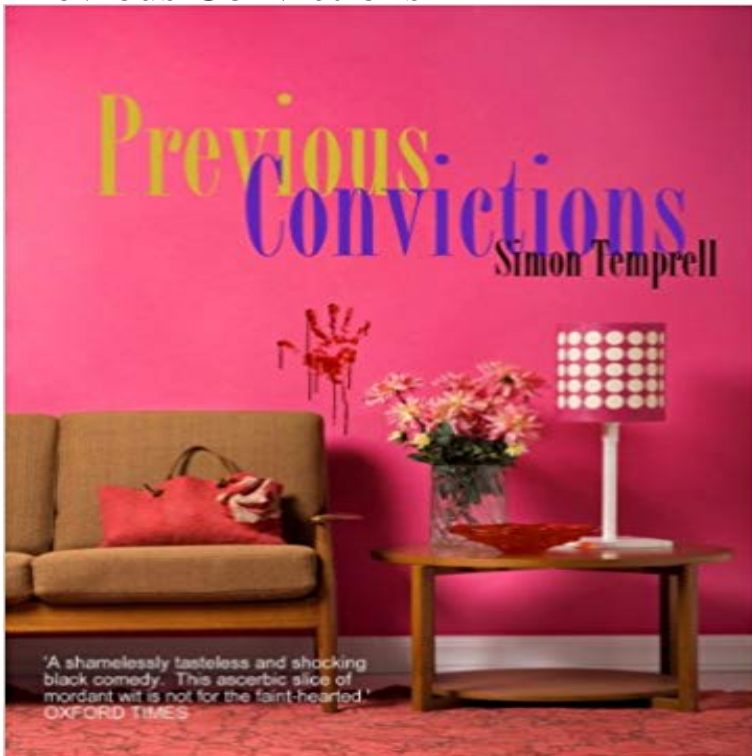


Previous Convictions
