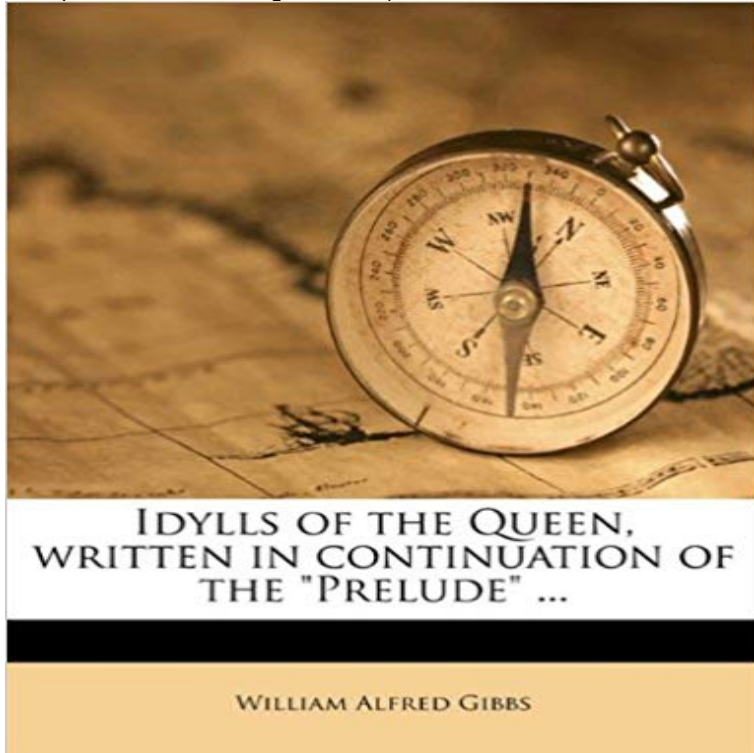


## Idylls of the Queen, written in continuation of the Prelude ...
