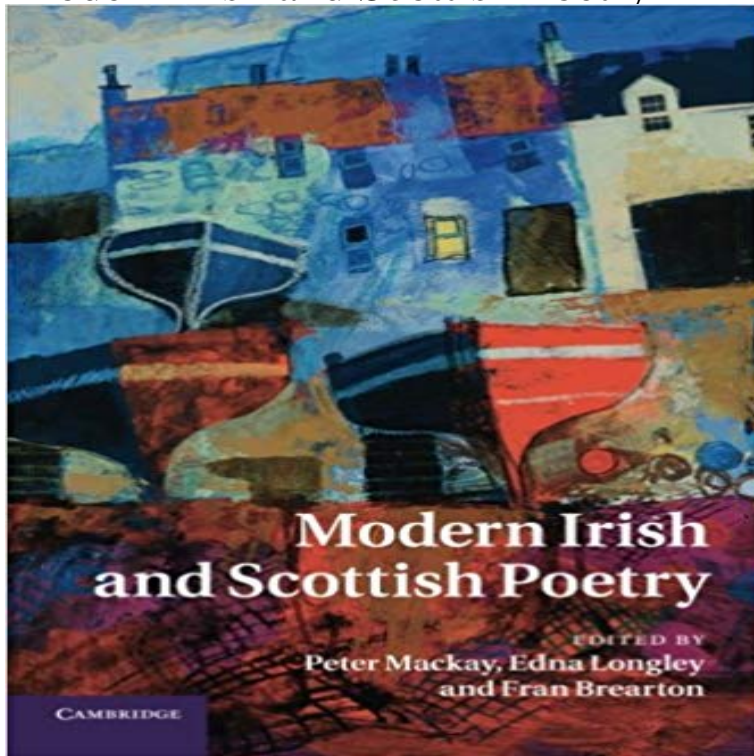


Modern Irish and Scottish Poetry
