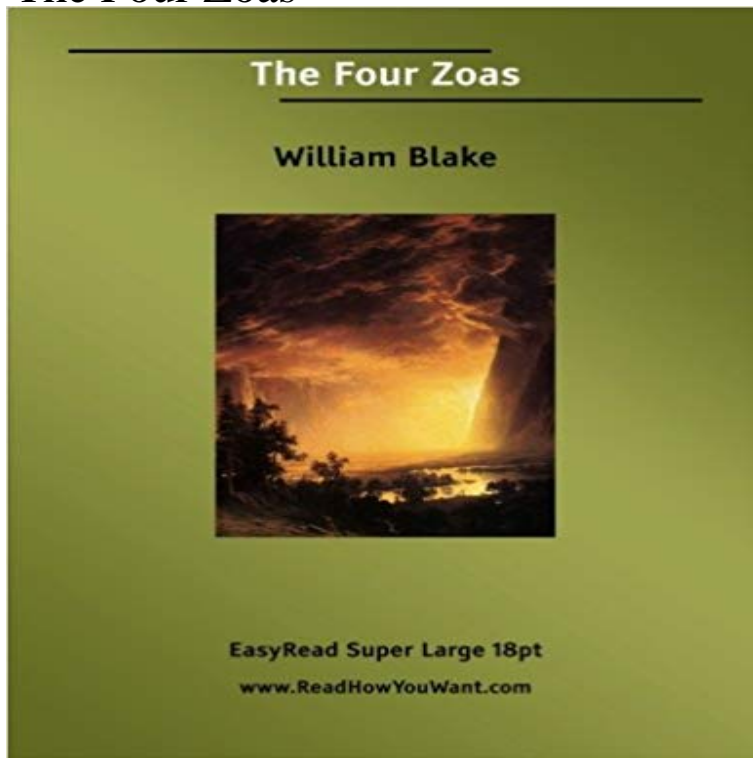


# The Four Zoas
